

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS SERVING SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has announced the availability of the 2025-2027 biennium Section 5310 Formula funds (\$2,311,301). Salem Area Mass Transit District (SAMTD) is a designated subrecipient by ODOT to oversee the distribution of Federal 5310 funds for Marion and Polk counties and is responsible for soliciting projects on a biennial basis. Section 5310 funds can be used for public transportation projects serving seniors and individuals with disabilities. Matching local funds are required for this grant. The match ratio is dependent on the type of project proposed. Projects must be listed in the Cherriots "Coordinated Public Transit – Human Services Transportation Plan" dated March 2024. A link to this document can be found at Cherriots.org/grants, and a list of eligible projects can be found in the tables of Chapter 6, beginning on p. 52.

These funds support projects and services from July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2027. Paper applications will not be accepted. Applications must be received by 5:00 p.m. on **October 25, 2024.**
